an over-the-door organizer or wall-mounted organizer would be best," says Smith. "If space allows, then a drawer or shelf organizer would be ideal. It is essential that organization tools suit the space."

Size and Capacity

The size of the lid organizer you purchase also depends on the amount of space you have. Some of the organizers on our list, like the <u>YouCopia StoraLid</u> <u>Expandable Container Lid Organizer</u>, are expandable, which helps maximize space.

It's also important to pay attention to the capacity of the lid organizer. And if your pot and pan lids are heavy, you'll want to ensure your organizer can hold their weight, especially for wall-mounted organizers.

Material

The material of your lid organizer may depend on the items you already have. You don't want the organizer's material to scratch or bend your lids. Most of the lid organizers on our list are plastic, steel, or metal, which is typically safe

Where should you put a lid organizer?

Placement can make a big difference when it comes to efficiently organizing. You should consider not just which lid organizer to purchase but also where to put it. "Locating a lid organizer near the containers that the lids go with is essential," says Smith. "So, based on the space available, the type of lid organizer can be determined." The lid organizers on our list can be placed on counters, inside cabinets and drawers, wall-mounted, or hung on doors.

How else can you use a lid organizer?

Get the most bang for your buck by using your lid organizer in multiple ways. "Another kitchen use for shelf organizers is to file cookie sheets, cooling racks, baking pans, and platters on them," says Smith.


